The Story: God Saves His People John 1:1-14

Sermon: Rejected By Many

Introduction:

• Rejection hurts, even when it's the best thing for us.

Context:

• The Messiah came in the flesh and was rejected by the world, even His own family and tribe.

1) Rejected (vs. 10-11)

- "Receive" means to 'welcome.' Jesus was not. Isaiah 53:3 prophesied that would be the case.
- Rejections are most painful in our most treasured relationships. However, often such rejection can be for our benefit (Rom. 8:28).

2) Re-Birth (v. 12a)

- Re-birth takes place in all who receive Him as Saviour and Lord. When we do, transformation happens. The Holy Spirit brings the breath of life to our souls.
- Christianity is about a relationship with the living God. It moves from the inside to the outside. From hearts to hands.

3) Re-Claimed (v. 12b-13)

- With re-birth, we have the right of being adopted into God's family. Only the obedient are really 'children of God.'
- Being a child of God is not dependent upon your heritage.

Conclusion:

- Jesus' message is still viral, even though often not 'liked.'
- Come to the cross; get to know Jesus; pray for the gift of faith.
